

INSTRUCTIONS:

This Product is IP20 rated. For proper operation, follow the **Installation guidelines described in this manual. Only qualified and** certified personnel should perform the installation and only the original rigging parts (brackets, holders, clamps, safety cables) included with this fixture should be used for installation. Any modifications will void the original manufactures warranty and increase the risk of damage and/or personal injury.

> Never look directly into the light source to prevent risk of injury to your retina, which may induce blindness. Those suffering from EPILEPSY should avoid looking directly into the light source of this unit at all times.

> The fan and air inlets must remain clean and never blocked. Allow approx. 6" (15cm) between this fixture and other devices or a wall for proper cooling.

> Always disconnect from main power source before performing any type of service and/or cleaning procedure. Only handle the power cord by the plug end, never pull by tugging the wire portion of the cord.

> Do NOT operate fixture if the power cord has become frayed, crimped and/or damaged. If the power cord is damaged, replace it immediately with a new one of similar power rating.

- > Do NOT operate fixture near any flammable materials.
- > Do NOT operate fixture in dusty environments.

> Fixture is IP20 rated and should be operated at the dry spaces. Fixture may get damaged to moistures and wet environments.


> This fixture has an inbuilt signal dimming system. Do NOT connect this fixture for external dimmer packs.


➢ We urge you to ensure proper mechanical fitments of clamps and a usage of safety chains while suspending from the top.









DMX-512 CONTROL CONNECTIONS

Connect the provided XLR cable to the female 3-pin XLR output of your controller and the other side to the male 3-pin XLR input of the moving head. You can chain multiple Moving head together through serial linking. The cable needed should be two core, screened cable with XLR input and output connectors. Please refer to the diagram below. DMX-512 connection with DMX terminator

INSTALLATIONS

Before mounting the fixture to any surface, make sure that the installation area can hold a minimum point load of 10 times the device's weight.

Fixture installation must always be secured with a secondary safety attachment, such as an appropriate safety cable.

Never stand directly below the device when mounting, removing, or servicing the fixture.

From a ceiling, or set on a flat. Be sure this fixture is kept at least 0.5m (1.5 ft) away from any flammable materials.

Please ensure that the led profile spotlight is hang using the appropriate "C" clamp or "O" Clamp. A safety chain or cable should also be used as a secondary point of holding the fixture in case the clamp comes loose. Never hang the fixture without a safety chain or cable.

There is an eye-bolt on the back of the fixture to which the safety chain or cable can threaded through and then hung from the secondary point. Make sure the Gel frame (Gel holder) is clipped into position correctly and cannot come loose.


If you are not qualified or have any doubts about hanging the led profile spotlight then do NOT hang it.



Do not clamp the safety cable to the U bracket or clamp. That is not a secondary safety point.

A secondary safety point is any point that will adequately hold the led profile spotlight if the "C" clamp or "O" Clamp fails.

Then the safety cable would be the backup and stop the fixture from falling to the ground. So do NOT fix the safety cable to the same place that the "C" clamp is attached.



Note:

In a DmX Mode, Light fixture will operate with 1 Channel. For a Bi Color Fixture 2 Channels will be utilized.

CW – Stands for Cool White 5600K, WW – Stands for Warm White 3200K.

Do NOT open the fixture for any kind of repair. There are parts which can be operated by authorized personnel only.
